

DEED of GIFT

AUSTRALIAN CHAMPIONSHIP TROPHY

This **TROPHY** was donated by the late Mr J McKennedy as a **PERPETUAL TROPHY** for **ANNUAL** Competition between 75 Cubic Inch Hydroplane Boats.

In **April 2001** The Australian Power Boat Association re-allocated the **TROPHY** to the **JUNIOR J2 Class** and the **TROPHY** history preserved by retention of all engraving and the name:

MACK KENNEDY TROPHY

This DEED of GIFT replaces the Original Deed of Gift.

1. The TROPHY shall be presented to the winner of the AUSTRALIAN CHAMPIONSHIP for the Class described, an Event open to Junior **J2** Class Boats only, the OWNERS and DRIVERS of which shall be Members of a Club affiliated with the Australian Power Boat Association.
2. The TROPHY shall be competed for ANNUALLY at such Venues and Dates as may be decided, and the Event conducted, in accordance with the current Rules of the Australian Power Boat Association.
3. The TROPHY shall be vested in the Australian Power Boat Association, but the possession of the TROPHY shall, from time to time, be held by the CLUB, or the OWNER of the Boat which represented such Club at the last competition, subject to its safe custody as may be deemed reasonable by the Australian Power Boat Association.
4. Should the required number of entries not be received for the period stated in the current Rules of the Australian Power Boat Association, or should the Class for which the TROPHY was re-allocated become redundant the TROPHY shall be returned to the Australian Power Boat Association for custody or further re-allocation at the discretion of the Australian Power Boat Association.
5. The TROPHY shall be returned prior to the Championship each year as required by the current Rules of the Australian Power Boat Association, and such COUNCIL, CLUB or PERSON taking possession of the TROPHY shall be deemed to have received the TROPHY in good condition unless a report is furnished to the NATIONAL SECRETARY in WRITING within fourteen days of receiving the TROPHY stating otherwise.
6. Championship CERTIFICATES shall be provided in accordance with the Rules of the Australian Power Boat Association, but the INSCRIPTION on the TROPHY shall be the responsibility of the OWNER.
7. ENTRIES will only be accepted on the condition that the craft entered and the competitor, or any person or persons connected therewith, whilst preparing for, and or participating in the Event, shall do so at their own risk and such persons shall have no claim against the Australian Power Boat Association, or any Official or Servant appointed or acting on behalf of the said Association in connection with the Event for any Injuries suffered by himself or to any persons, or in respect to damage to the craft entered.
