


DEED OF GIFT
AUSTRALIAN CHAMPIONSHIP TROPHY

THE TROPHY WAS DONATED BY MRS SHRILEY TURVEY IN 1997 AS A PERPETUAL TROPHY FOR ANNUAL COMPETITION BETWEEN INBOARD MOTOR POWERED CRAFT FOR THE GRAND PRIX HYDROPLANE CLASS CONFORMING TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE AUSTRALIAN POWER BOAT ASSOCIATION, AND SHALL BE KNOWN AS THE

"MARY AND ERNIE NUNN GRAND PRIX HYDROPLANE CHAMPIONSHIP"


1. The TROPHY shall be presented to the OWNER of the craft winning the AUSTRALIAN CHAMPIONSHIP for the Class herein described, an Event for GRAND PRIX HYDROPLANES only, the OWNERS of which shall be members of a Club affiliated with the Australian Power Boat Association. Overseas entrants are eligible to compete however OWNERS must be members of a similar Club of the country to be represented.
2. The TROPHY shall be competed for ANNUALLY at such a Date and Venue, and the Event conducted, in accordance with the current Rules of the Australian Power Boat Association. The TROPHY shall annually be competed for only on Australian waters.
3. The TROPHY shall be vested in the Australian Power Boat Association, but the possession of the TROPHY, shall, from time to time, be held by the CLUB, or the OWNER of the Boat, which represented such Club at the last competition, subject to its safe custody as may be deemed responsible by the Australian Power Boat Association.
4. If an overseas entrant wins the championship, the TROPHY must remain in Australia.
5. Should the required number of ENTRIES, not be received for the period stated in the current Rules of the Australian Power Boat Association, or should the Class for which the TROPHY was donated become redundant, the TROPHY shall be returned to the NATIONAL COUNCIL for custody.
6. The TROPHY shall be returned prior to the Championship each year as required by the current rules of the Australian Power Boat Association, and such COUNCIL, CLUB or PERSON taking possession of the TROPHY shall be deemed to have received such TROPHY in good condition unless a report is furnished to the NATIONAL SECRETARY in WRITING, with FOURTEEN days stating otherwise.
7. Championship CERTIFICATES shall be provided in accordance with the current rules of the Australian Power Boat Association, but the INSCRIPTION on the TROPHY after each competition shall be the responsibility of the winning OWNER.
8. ENTRIES will only be accepted on the condition that the craft and competition, or any person, or persons connected therewith, whilst preparing for, and or participating in the Event, shall do so at their own risk, and such persons shall have no claim against the DONOR, the Australian Power Boat Association, or any OFFICIAL, or SERVANT appointed or acting on behalf of the said Organisation in connection with the Event for any injuries suffered by themselves or to any persons, or in respect to damage to the craft entered.
