

DEED of GIFT.

AUSTRALIAN CHAMPIONSHIP TROPHY.

This TROPHY was donated by Mr. M. C. STANNARD of 75 Lake Monger Drive, WEMBLEY, West Australia, 6014, in 1978 as a PERPETUAL TROPHY for ANNUAL competition between INBOARD and OUTBOARD powered Speedboats and shall be known as


THE STANNARD CUP

1. The TROPHY shall be presented to the WINNER of the AUSTRALIAN OPEN UNLIMITED CHAMPIONSHIP an EVENT open to INBOARD and OUTBOARD powered craft the Owners and Drivers of which must be Members of a Club affiliated with the Australian Power Boat Association.
2. The TROPHY shall be competed for ANNUALLY at such venue as the Australian Power Boat Association may decide at its Annual General Meeting and shall be competed for under the current INBOARD Rules of the Australian Power Boat Association. The TROPHY is to be contested in each State on a rotational basis between West Australia, South Australia, Victoria, New South Wales, Tasmania, and Queensland. Any State has the right of refusal to conduct the Event. Should any State exercise this right, the conduct of the Event is then offered to the next State in rotation.
3. The contest shall be under the control of the Australian Power Boat Association whose decision in all respects shall be final and the said Association shall have the power from time to time to alter or amend the rules and regulations governing the contests not inconsistent with this Deed.
4. There shall be no restriction on power or hull design excepting as set down in the Rules of the Australian Power Boat Association.
5. The Event shall be conducted on the Standard Course as defined in the Rules of the Australian Power Boat Association.
6. The TROPHY shall be vested in the Australian Power Boat Association but possession of the TROPHY, shall, from time to time be by the Club, or the Owner of the winning Boat which represented such Club at the last competition, subject to its safe custody as may be deemed reasonable by the Australian Power Boat Association.
7. The TROPHY shall be returned prior to the contest each year as stated in the Rules of the Australian Power Boat Association, and such Council, Club, or Person taking possession of the TROPHY shall be deemed to have received such TROPHY in good condition unless a report is furnished to the FEDERAL SECRETARY of the Australian Power Boat Association in writing, within fourteen (14) days, stating otherwise.
8. A Championship Certificate is to be provided by the Australian Power Boat Association in accordance with current Rules, but the INSCRIPTION on the TROPHY shall be the responsibility of the winning Owner.

This AMENDED Deed of Gift replaces any previous Deed of Gift and was SIGNED for and on behalf of the DONOR this thirteenth day of DECEMBER 1985.
