COMMENCING 1ST January 2010

Helmet Restraints and / or Breakaway Clips

801.04 - HELMET RESTRAINTS AND/OR BREAKAWAY CLIPS FOR DRIVERS AND RIDING CREW IN INBOARD AND OUTBOARD BOATS NOT FITTED WITH A REINFORCED COCKPIT.

801.041 – From 1 January 2010 – All Drivers and Riding Crew <u>MUST</u> use one of the following on their helmet:

A helmet restraint; of a type that restricts movement of the head and secures to the body or arms by straps or other means; or

A plastic-type breakaway clip on the standard helmet strap

801.042 – The wearer is entirely responsible for the effectiveness of the helmet restraint or breakaway clip

Ballistic Pants

801.06 – BALLISTIC PANTS FOR DRIVERS AND RIDING CREW IN ALL INBOARD AND OUTBOARD BOATS NOT FITTED WITH A REINFORCED COCKPIT.

801.061 – From 1 January 2010 – All Drivers and Riding Crew in addition to the protective clothing mentioned in 801.05 MUST wear pants (either long or short) made of a ballistic type material.

- Kevlar a cut and abrasion resistant material
- Spectra a cut and abrasion resistant material
- TUFF-N-LITE the highest rated cut and abrasion resistant material
